Entry Fees

The entry fees are **€3,295 for the first driver**, €870 for the second driver, and €470 for each accompanying person.

Garage rental for 2 days costs €340 for shared (2-person) occupancy or €680 for exclusive occupancy.

Cancellation-Policy

From the 20th day before the event (arrival day), the full entry fee will be retained.

From the 40th day before the event, 50% of the paid entry fee will be retained.

From the 60th day before the event, either 30% of the entry fee will be retained, or the full entry fee can be credited toward a future NJ Driving School event.

Hotel (Note: Self-Pay!)

Our event hotel is the 4-star Hotel de la Source, located directly at the racetrack, where our evening events also take place. A block of rooms has been reserved for participants. Accommodation is on a self-pay basis. NJ Driving School assumes no liability for any cancellation fees that may apply. Any changes or cancellations to room reservations must be made directly with the hotel at least 3 days before the event.

Registration

By registering, the participant confirms their binding participation and accepts the regulations of the NJ Driving School. The entry fee must be transferred immediately after receiving the registration confirmation to the account specified in the confirmation. Participant numbers are limited. Registration becomes binding only upon our written confirmation to the participant. Without timely payment of the entry fee, the registration will not be considered, and no starting place will be reserved.

For safety reasons, this training is conducted exclusively on the 7-kilometer-long F1 circuit of Spa-Francorchamps and serves solely the purpose of advanced driver safety training.

Iconic corners such as La Source, Eau Rouge, Raidillon, Les Combes, Malmedy, Bruxelles, Pouhon, Campus, Paul Frère, Blanchimont, and the Chicane, each with their unique characteristics, help you learn precise and confident control of your vehicle through the interaction of driver, car, and track-delivering pure and safe driving enjoyment.

Our highly qualified and experienced instructors will teach you the correct steering techniques, precise pedal control, and provide maximum driving enjoyment over two intensive days. After completing the training, you will be able to handle critical situations in everyday traffic with greater confidence and routine.

Participants are divided into five compact groups, ensuring individual, intensive, and personal coaching by our top instructors. Numerous training sessions and extended open driving periods on the full circuit on both days allow you to independently refine and perfect what you have learned. These two days will be an unforgettable experience for every participant.

Catering is provided throughout the day with a box café and lunch service during the event. The hotel is located directly at the racetrack and also serves as the venue for our shared evening dinners, where participants and instructors can exchange experiences and impressions from the day in a relaxed atmosphere.
